

The importance of international collaboration for Santo Tomas institutions

However, one of the issues of international collaboration is how to concrete specific projects with the partners institutions and not have only agreements in papers.


We focus in specific educational areas with ours partners

- With the People's Republic of China, after 10 years of close and friendly relations with many higher education institutions, we have developed many joint projects in Management, Education, Sports and Health areas.
- Furthermore, we house a Confucius Institute in our Viña del Mar campus.
